Summary

Serves a floater on Sunday mornings to assist trained CCC Kids volunteers in the classroom. Parent Assistants are vital to the success of Sunday mornings providing an extra set of hands to help our volunteers run a safe and effective classroom. Our policy is to have a minimum of two adult volunteers in each room, but when Sunday attendance is high, extra help is needed in the classroom. Families win when we work together to lead kids in a growing relationship with Jesus Christ.

Duties

As a Parent Assistant you **DO NOT have to teach.**

You may be asked to help with the following:

Nursery Area

- Hold babies, console children, sit on the floor to play, help maintain safe interaction between children.

Toddler/Preschool Area

- Monitor children to insure a safe classroom experience.
- Console a child who may be sad, help distribute classroom supplies such as crayons, papers, craft items, write names on papers, help with game activities, assist children in making a craft, sit at a table with children, repeat verses or things they learned in the Bible story, talk with children at the table, help gather children's belongings during pick up.

Elementary Area

- Assist children in making a craft, talk with children at the table.
- Help with games or activities as instructed by the teachers.
- Distribute supplies such as crayons, papers, craft items.
- Listen to children recite their Bible verse; Help distribute CCC Kids bucks
