KEY THOUGHTS

- Creation is waiting to be renewed and restored back to its original glory.
- The Christian life is going to have sickness, suffering, pain, etc in our life, but the weight that compares to those is nothing compared to the glory that is coming.
- You are in a season of waiting.
- Be encouraged that the Holy Spirit groans (stands) for you.

- Who's good are you most inclined to believe? Or another to put it, Do you trust in His purpose?
